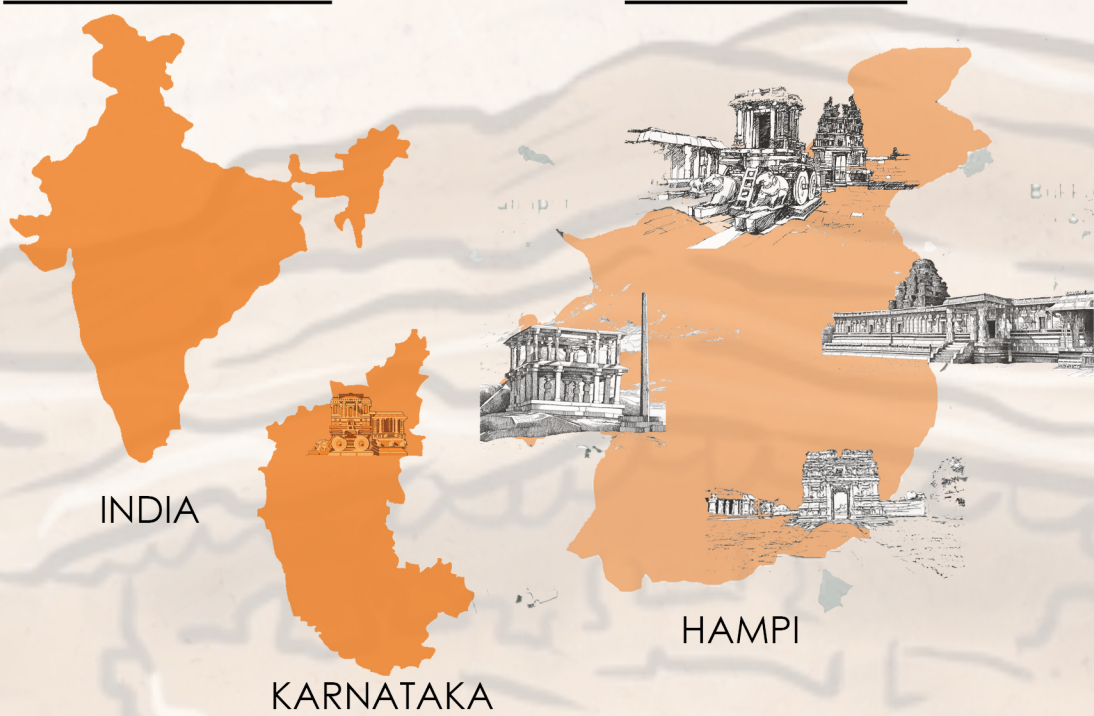

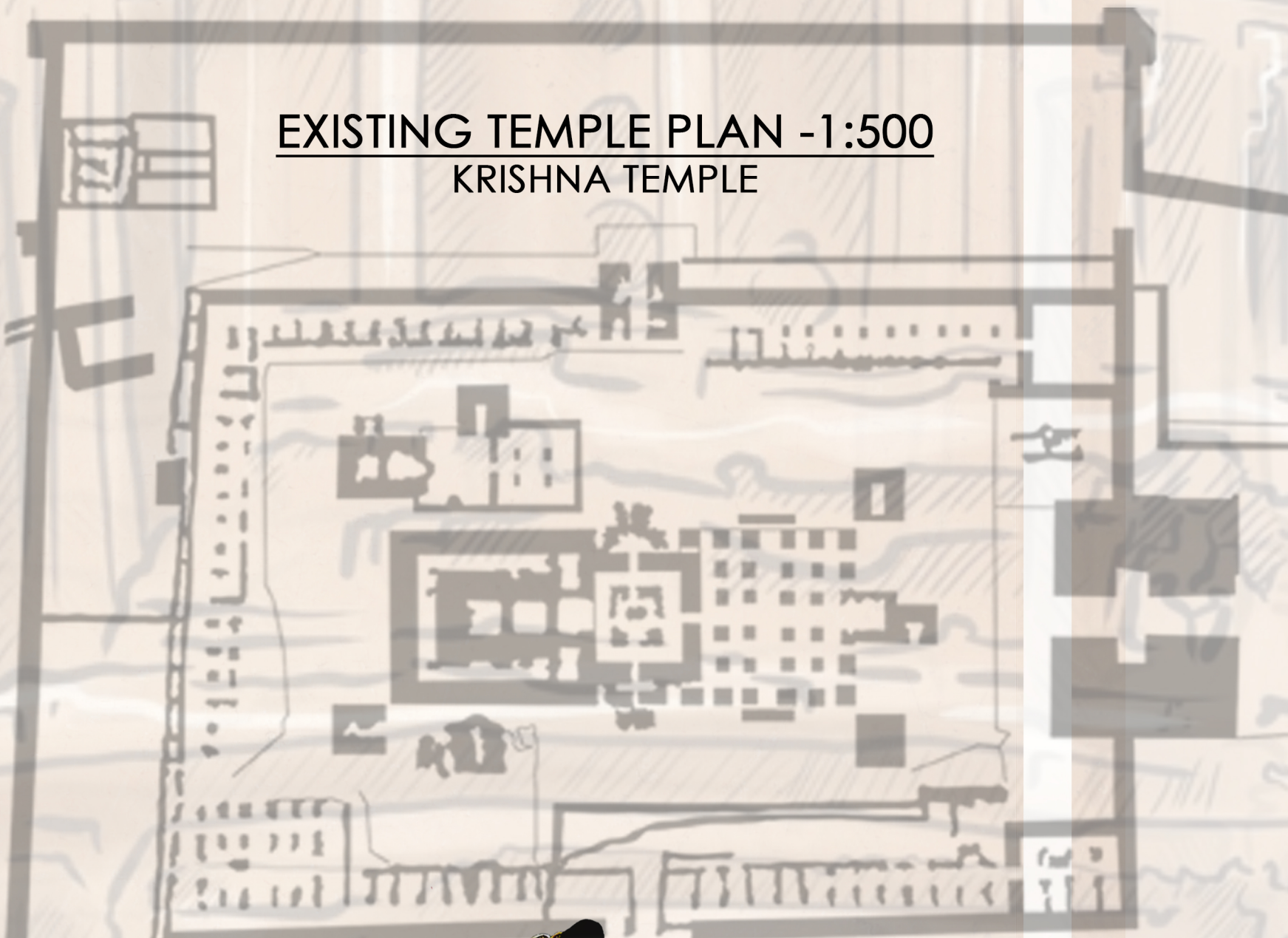

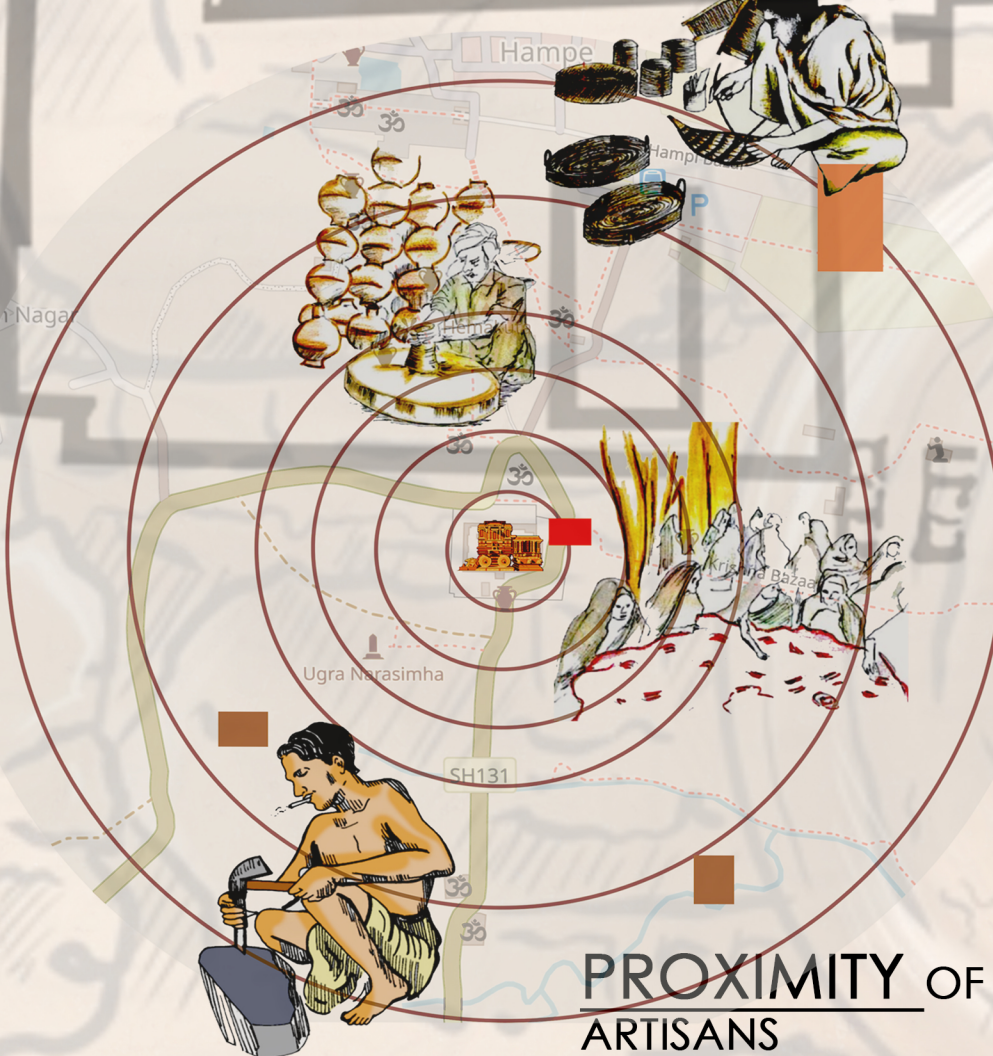
CONTEXT

SECTION OF THE TEMPLE COMPLEX - 1:500

Hampi is an ancient historic site which was built by Krishnadevaraya, in the sixteenth century for his victory over orissa. The city of victory is in ruins where tourists around the globe visit. This city is an UNESCO world heritage site.

Our design endeavors to utilize the spaces of the ruined Sri Krishna Swami Temple Complex which was the first religious monument constructed in the city. The intervention is to make use of the Old Bazaar street(chariot street) and spaces in and around the kalyani.



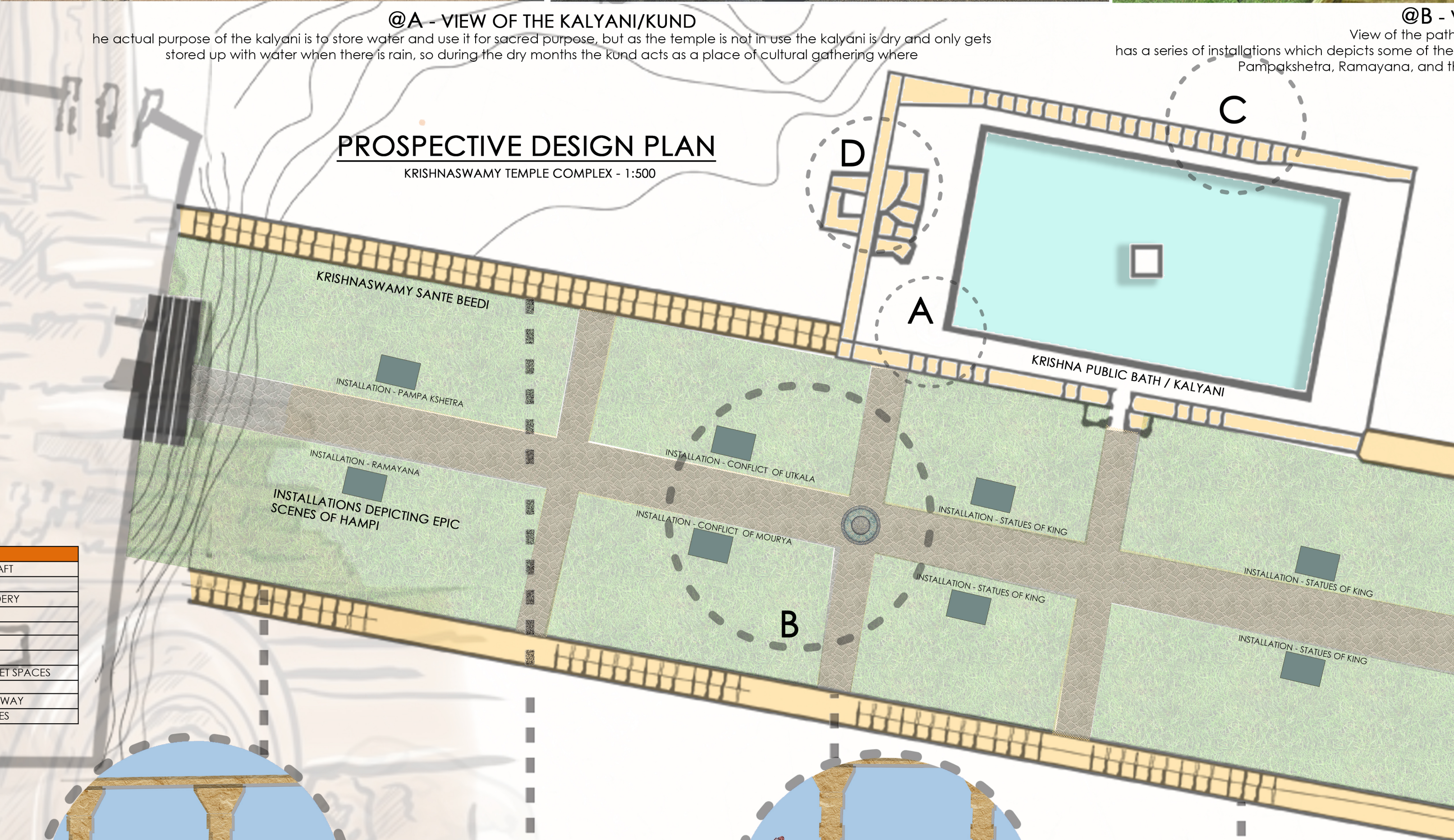
@A - VIEW OF THE KALYANI/KUND

he actual purpose of the kalyani is to store water and use it for sacred purpose, but as the temple is not in use the kalyani is dry and only gets stored up with water when there is rain, so during the dry months the kund acts as a place of cultural gathering where

View of the pathway leading to the bazaar and kalyani: has a series of installations which depicts some of the epic scenes that have been developed in hampi, these include scenes from Pampakshetra, Ramayana, and the war victory from the Mauryan and the Orissa kingdom.

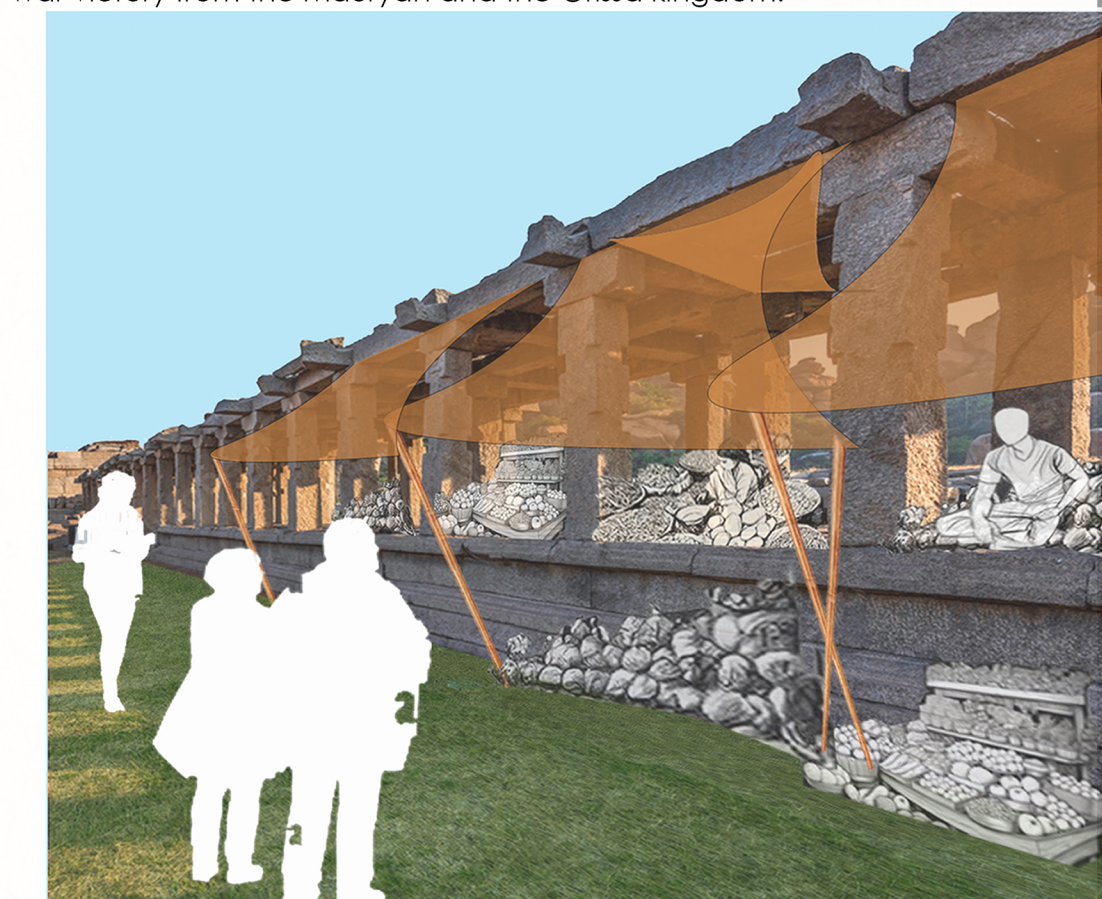

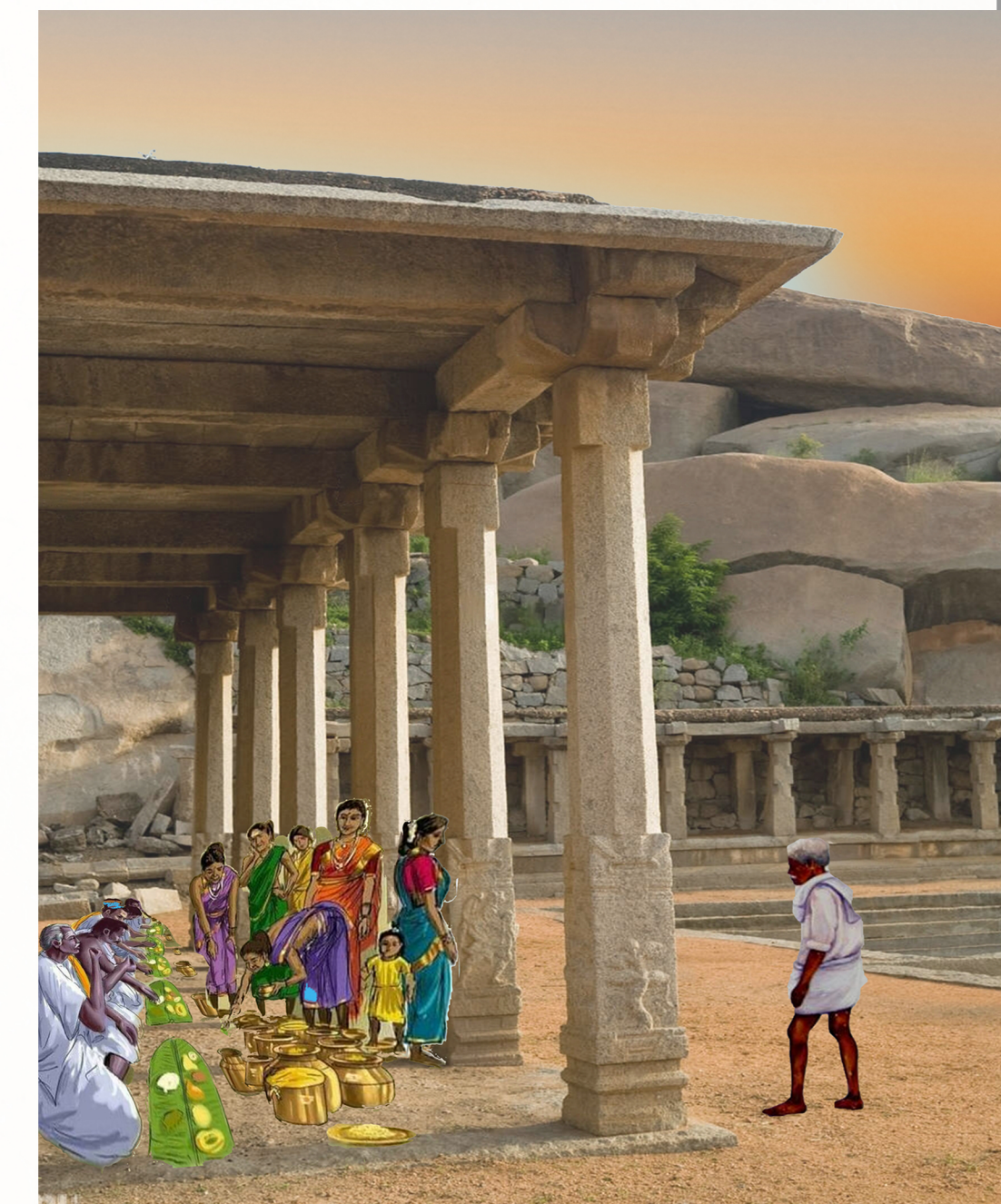
